

## Accessibility

The museum is a mill from the Late Middle Ages and protected as a historical monument.

The museum's four floors are connected by a large lift (210 x 100 cm / 7 x 3 ft.). Fixed or flexible ramps are provided for most of the doors, so that except for two rooms in the cellar, all rooms can be accessed by wheelchair (max. 70 cm / 28 in. wide).

A wheelchair is available and there is also an accessible toilet. Please inquire at the shop.

Museum employees are at work in various parts of the building. They are available to answer questions and be of assistance. Our typesetting area for visitors includes a typecase for wheelchair use.

## Getting there

**By Car:** No parking spaces are available in front of the museum! Some can be found in the surrounding area (max. 1 hr.). Given sufficient notice, we can arrange a parking space for those with disabilities.

**Public transport:** Tram number 1, 2 and 15 (Kunstmuseum) or tram 3 (St. Alban-Tor) stop within walking distance of the museum. Signposts show the direction to the Museum (Papiermühle). Both routes have a short, fairly steep hill. The closest stop without gradient is Waldenburgerstrasse (Tram 3), about 600 meters away (see map below).
